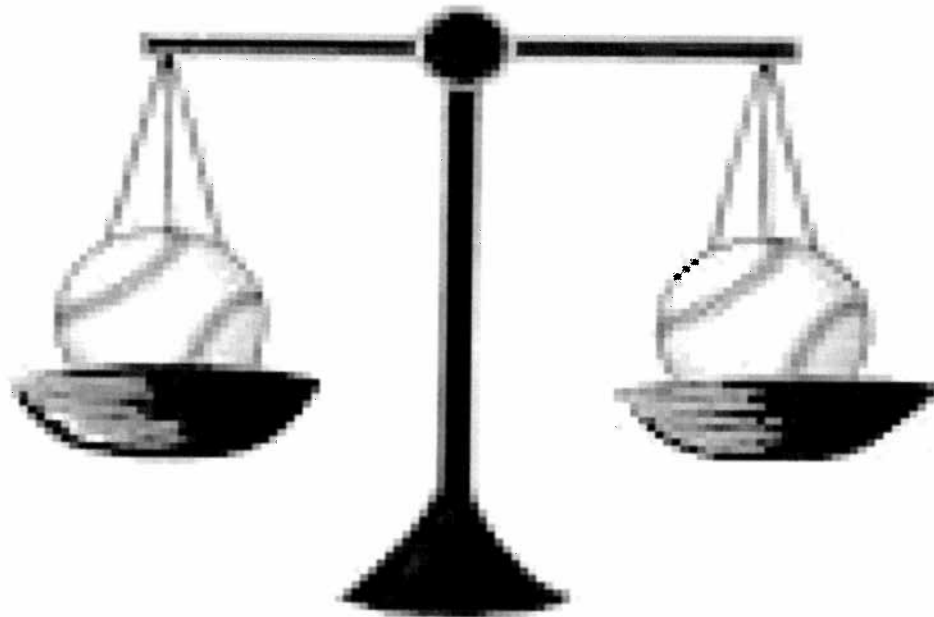

ELIGIBILITY

Regular Season and Playoffs

The following players are eligible to compete in the league:

1. Lawyers
2. Paralegals
3. Law Students
4. Individuals who have a law degree but are not practicing attorneys
5. Judges
6. Court Personnel (Excluding Law Enforcement)
7. Full time employees of a law firm or legal office.
8. Full time employees of the following governmental offices: District Attorney's Office, Public Defenders Office, United States Attorney's Office, Attorney General's Office and Federal Public Defenders Office.

An eligible player must participate in a minimum of 50% of a team's regular season games to be eligible to compete in the playoffs.

A team may use three (3) Ringers during any regular season or playoff game. A Ringer is defined as any player who does not fit into categories 1-8 above. In order for a ringer to be eligible for playoff competition, he/she must have played in at least 50% of his/her team's regular season games.

In certain prior seasons, following each game, teams were required to email to the Commissioner a list of all players who played in the game and designating which players were Ringers. This season, like last season, you are required to email a list of the *Ringers only*. The 50% rule for eligible players is still in effect. This year you will be sending your weekly email reports to me at sgrego@dmclaw.com. I encourage you to send your game reports the day after a game is played so that we can keep accurate records. Sending this email should take you no more than 60 seconds so please make it a priority. This also allows us to update our league website in a timely fashion to provide you with accurate scores and standings. Your game report email must contain the following information:

- Game score
- List of ringers (if applicable)

At the end of the regular season, it will be determined which Ringers are eligible to compete in the playoffs. No more than three (3) eligible Ringers may compete in a playoff game per team, even if more than three Ringers have obtained eligibility during the regular season. Obviously, we are using the honor system when it comes to team captains submitting legitimate names. The entire system depends on it. Any team found submitting false information concerning players will not be allowed to use any Ringers in the playoffs.

The purposes of these rules are twofold:

1. To have teams comprised primarily of individuals who are lawyers or in the legal profession.
2. To ensure that a team competing in the playoffs is comprised of essentially the same players who competed together during the regular season.

LEAGUE RULES

1. Teams shall be permitted to play if they have 8 or more ballplayers. If a team has only 8 ballplayers, then the opposing team is required to supply a catcher to the team with 8 players although the catcher shall serve as a courtesy catcher for returning the ball to the pitcher. The catcher is not required to make plays at home plate. If a team has only 9 ballplayers, then the opposing team is not required to supply a catcher but may do so if they wish. This rule applies to the regular season as well as the playoffs.

2. There are no metal spikes allowed in this league

3. In order to be eligible for any playoffs at the end of the year, your total number of wins and losses from games actually played (which includes forfeit wins) must equal or exceed one-half (1/2) of the games scheduled. If weather significantly affects the field conditions throughout the summer, the Commissioner may use his discretion to make exceptions.

4. No team can unilaterally cancel a game for any reason. Both teams must agree to cancel a game and both teams have responsibility for calling the umpires (**Dennis Reft 412-344-6105**) and myself, upon cancellation.

5. Each team is responsible for bringing one new softball and a set of bases to each game; however, the failure of a team to bring these items does not result in any penalty to that team. (There have been times when umpires have refused to umpire games for failure to bring necessary game equipment such as bases and balls. There is no remedy for this, so I urge you to bring the equipment and not rely on the other team.)

6. There is a twelve run rule, which terminates the game if one team is ahead by twelve runs or more after the completion of five or more complete innings.

7. On fields where two games are scheduled for the same day, the first game

is to begin as promptly as possible and no new inning is to be begun after the starting time of the second game. If the game is required to be stopped before the completion of seven (7) innings, then the score at the end of the last completed inning will become the final score. This is important because the lights will automatically shut off at 9:45 each night, except for Thursdays when they will shut off at 10:30.

8. Our league is using the American Softball Association (A.S.A.) Rule relating to approved bats. For the complete list, see their web site at www.asasoftball.com. All bats banned by the A.S.A. are illegal. Use of an illegal bat results in the batter being declared out with no runners advancing. The bat shall be removed from the game. Repeated use of the bat shall also result in the ejection of the player using the illegal bat previously removed from the game.

9. For all games played at Dan Marino Field, there are two (2) special ground rules: (a) First, the second time a batter hits a ball over the second fence on the first base side in foul territory in the same at bat is an out. That batter's at-bat terminates, an out is recorded, and runners do not advance. There is no such rule for the left field side of the ball field. (b) The second Dan Marino ground rule is put in play when there is an overthrow at third base. The macadam walkway is out of play. Because the macadam behind third base is so close to the field of play, they are awarded only third base. If they are one step before third base when the ball goes out of play, they are awarded only third base. If they are one step beyond second base, they are awarded third base. Likewise for all other bases. This applies only to thrown balls which go out of play behind third base. This does not apply to thrown balls which go into left field or in the left field foul area. This does not apply to balls that go out of play between the backstop and the fence along the third base line.

10. General rules of play are directed by the American Softball Association Rule Book unless otherwise specified herein or in any supplement hereto.

11. The following rules pertain to base running:

(a) Regular Season – The last batted out player may pinch run for any injured (or “impaired”) player who is on base.

(b) Playoffs –

(i) Each team may designate one player each game who can be pinch run for during the course of the game. This designation does not require an injury and can be used for any player selected by the team. Once a designated player is selected, the designation cannot be changed and any other pinch runner is subject to the rule in 11 (b)(ii) below. If a team chooses to designate a player to be pinch run for, the designated player may not run for himself/herself under any circumstances during the game. When a designated

player reaches base during the game, he/she shall be run for by the player making the last batted out. The designation of a pinch runner can be made prior to the game or at any point during the game if no designation had previously been made. (Example - A team may wish to save their designation of a pinch runner to be used later in the course of the game in the event one of their players is injured during the course of the game. Otherwise, if a designated runner has already been selected, and an injury occurs to another team member, Rule 11(b)(ii) would be applicable to any runner who is pinch running for the injured player. In the event the designation has been saved, the injured player can be designated at the time of injury, and any time such player reaches base, the last batted out may run for such player without Rule 11(b)(ii) being applicable).

Notwithstanding the detailed terms of Rule 11(b)(i) above, each opposing team manager retains the absolute discretion to waive the application of such Rule in the event of unexpected injury (or base-hitting).

- (ii) The One Re-Entry/Substitution Rule – Any player who is not currently in the game (or who has not previously been in the game) may pinch run and/or be substituted for a player currently in the game. The player who has been replaced may return to the game in the same slot he left the game. The original replacement may return to the game one more time but only in the slot he had previously been placed. Once the original substitute has re-entered the game, the original player may not return to the game.

12. All batters start their at bat with one strike. The initial count is 0-1.
13. There is no base stealing in this league.
14. A coin toss at the beginning of each game during the regular season will determine the home team for that game.
15. During league play there is no foul ball rule which means that you cannot be put out on strikes after hitting a foul ball regardless of how many foul balls you have hit, except as set forth in Rule 9 hereinabove .
16. Teams may use a DH if the opposing team gives consent. Rule 11 applies separately for the DH(batter) and the fielder.

Generally, we have two open timeslots per week: the last time slot on Mondays (commencing 8:00 p.m.) and the last time slot on Thursdays (commencing 9:00 p.m.). Teams are encouraged to make up rain outs/cancelled games. There are 27 open timeslots on the season's schedule for this purpose. (The last regular season week – August 29-31 – has no games scheduled and is also reserved for make-ups.) We have paid for these permits and want teams to reschedule their makeup games. Total games played will be a factor in playoff seeding which is discussed in Rule 5 below.

2. Notice of cancellation of a game must be made 24 hours prior to the game (non-weather related cancellations). Failure to do so will result in a forfeit if the team cannot field enough players. If a team gives 24 hours' advanced notice that they might not be able to play, and ultimately cannot play, the opposing team has the option to consent to the cancellation (thereby not imposing a forfeit). The goal of this rule is to eliminate cancellations the day of a game without prior notice and to permit the time slots to be utilized as make up dates if possible.

3. Teams who fail to comply with Rule 2 above without communication of their intentions or inability to appear shall be subject to expulsion from the League for repeated occurrences. In the event an opponent does not appear at a game (without prior notification), the team that has appeared at the field shall have the umpire sign a scorebook (or other paper) indicating that the other team did not appear. The coach should then contact the Commissioner (by e-mail or at 412-392-5507) to report the specific team which did not appear. Upon receipt of a first complaint, a team will be issued a formal warning. Upon receipt of two complaints, I will then issue a fine of \$60 to the offending team (\$60 being representative of the approximate cost of playing a game, i.e., permit, umpires, equipment). Upon receipt of three complaints, the team will be expelled from the League and prohibited from further play.

5. Playoff seeding will be determined as follows: At the end of the regular season, each team captain is encouraged to submit a ranking of the teams in their Division (teams will not rank their own team). These rankings will be combined with other factors that include winning percentage, games played and forfeits to ultimately determine the playoff seedings. Teams are not required to submit rankings, but are encouraged to do so if they would like to have input in the playoff seedings. Home team for the playoffs will be determined by seeding. (The team with the higher seed is the home team.)

6. Team Captains are expected to inform their players of the League rules.
